Independent Auditor's Review Report To The Board of Directors, Sundaram Brake Linings Limited

Re: Limited Review Report for the quarter and half year ended 30 September 2021

- We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of unaudited financial results of Sundaram Brake Linings
